# Available Now: 2021-2022 FAFSA Application

You may be eligible to receive financial aid to help pay for college, but you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. The new 2021-22 FAFSA application is available NOW! You should fill it out as soon as possible at FAFSA.gov and use FSW school code 001477. Remember, a FAFSA needs to be completed every year to determine eligibility for grants, loans, workstudy opportunities, and FSW scholarships.


