Answer: Students will receive a refund if their financial aid award is greater than the charges that can be paid with financial aid on their FSW bill. Be sure to establish your <u>BankMobile Refund Preference</u>, so we know where to send your refund. Refunds are processed after Attendance Verification each term and within 14 days of when we apply funds to your FSW bill.
