Question Of The Week

"My financial situation has changed since filing the FAFSA. What are my options"?

Answer: If you have experienced the loss of a job, a large reduction in income, or extraordinary medical expenses, request a "Family Contribution Appeal," found at <u>fsw.verifymyfafsa.com</u>, to have your financial aid status reviewed on a case by case basis. Note: the FAFSA itself cannot be updated to reflect your current financial situation. The Family Contribution Appeal for a change of circumstance can be used for unique circumstances.
