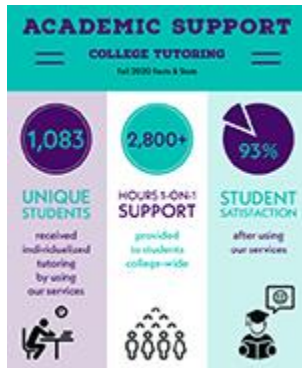


Cashier's Office Hours

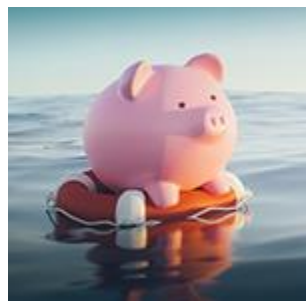
FSW Spring Virtual Transfer Fair

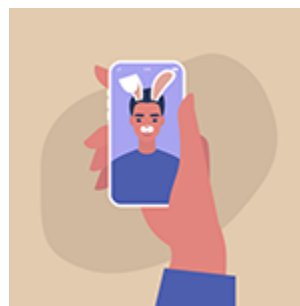


Credit Card Makeover: Getting Out Of Debt

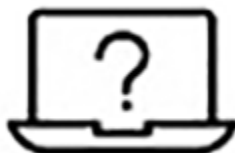
