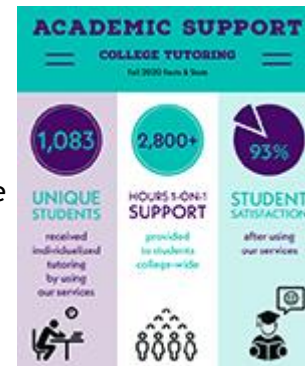


Mental Health Resources

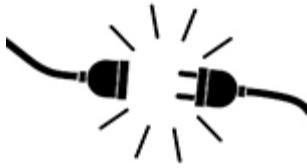
Creating Healthy And Sustainable Habits
